What is this subject?

This is a multi-skills course in construction offering students a taster of a wide range of construction jobs and the chance to develop skills from scratch. Students will have the opportunity to study units in carpentry, electrical installation, plumbing and bricklaying.

Qualifications and course requirements

Construction Multi-skills: Level 1. As this is an off-site provision, attendance on the full-day course (10am to 3pm) will need to be good, as there won't be an opportunity to catch up in school.

Students will be supported by a member of staff from the school.

What future jobs and college courses can students go onto?

This Level 1 course will allow students to move onto Level 2 courses in most areas of construction including:

- carpentry
- electrical installation
- plumbing
- bricklaying

It will also make students more competitive in applications for apprenticeships as they will be seen as having a wide range of skills.

Possible visits and work experience

This is an off-site option. At New River College, we can support you to get work experience in specific areas of construction during Work Experience week.
